PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Ulcers at gastrojejunostomy .
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsies from gastrojejunostomy, stoma.

GROSS:

Fragments of collective size 5x4 mm.

MICROSCOPIC:

There is focal ulceration of the gastric mucosa with the non-ulcerated areas showing moderate atrophy of glands and dense infiltration by lymphocytes and plasma cells. Some neutrophils are seen infiltrating glands indicating activity. H. pylori characteristic forms are not seen colonizing glands. Fragments of small intestinal mucosa are seen infiltrated by the same inflammatory cells. No evidence of atypia or malignancy.

DIAGNOSIS:

Gastrojejunostomy, endoscopic biopsy:

- Moderate chronic gastrojejunitis with active inflammatory ulceration.
- H. Pylori forms are not seen.
- Negative for atypia or malignancy.
